STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT authorizing the Bangor Boom Company to erect a
pier in Penobscot river.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Bangor Boom Company is hereby
2 authorized to erect and maintain within its limits on the
3 westerly side of Penobscot river, a pier nearly opposite
4 the northerly line of Daniel Webster's farm, and to be
5 within three hundred feet from the westerly bank of the
6 river; said pier to be located, to be of such size and pro-
7 portions, and to be constructed as shall be determined
8 by Joab W. Palmer and William Connors, of Bangor.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
