IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT relative to Fishing in the Tributaries of Lermond  
and Alford Ponds in the County of Knox.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from  
2 fishing in any manner for fish of any kind in all of the  
3 tributaries leading into or tributary to Lermond's and  
4 Alford's Ponds in the county of Knox for the term of six  
5 years.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this  
2 act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for each  
3 offence to be recovered by complaint, one-half to the use  
4 of the prosecutor and one-half to the use of the county of  
5 Knox.
