STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter five hundred and
seventy-four, Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
and fifty-six, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kendall's
Mills Village Corporation" and all acts amendatory thereto.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section two of said act as amended by chap-
2 ter one hundred thirty-nine, Private and Special Laws of
3 eighteen hundred ninety-one, by striking out the word
4 "and" in the twelfth line and adding to said section at
5 the end thereof, the following words, 'and for purchasing
6 land for and maintaining burial grounds,' so that said sec-
7 tion as amended shall read:

‘Section 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized and
9 vested with the power at any legal meeting called for the
10 purposes to raise money to defray the expenses of a night
11 watch, of a police, and all other necessary measures, for
12 the better security of life and property, and for the pro-
13 motion of good order, and the observance of the laws
14 within its limits, for purchasing and keeping in repair
15 engines and other apparatus for the extinguishment of
16 fires, for the construction of reservoirs and aqueducts to
17 supply water ; for the erection and keeping in repair situa-
18 ble engine houses ; for organizing and maintaining an effi-
19 cient fire department ; for ringing the bell ; for constructing
20 and maintaining public sewers within said corporation
21 limits, and for purchasing land for and maintaining burial
22 grounds.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
