STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to change the outlet of Kidder Pond in Vienna.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Perley Whittier, George H. Mooers, Henry
2 Trask and E. N. Allen, all of Vienna, are hereby authorized
3 and empowered to change the outlet of Kidder pond in
4 Vienna, now running into Long pond in Belgrade, so that
5 said outlet shall flow into Flying pond in said Vienna.
6 *Provided, however,* that the water in said Kidder pond
7 shall not be drawn down at any time, below its natural
8 level in time of drought.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
