### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter Eighty-Six of the Revised
Statutes relating to Trustee Suits.

B: it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of chapter eighty-six of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end
- 3 thereof the following words: 'When a partnership is made
- 4 a trustee in a trustee suit, service upon one member of
- 5 the firm shall be a sufficient attachment of the property
- 6 of the principal defendant in the possession of the firm,
- 7 provided legal service shall be afterwards made upon the
- 8 other members of the firm.'

- SECT. 2. Section six of chapter eighty-six of the
- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end
- 3 thereof the following words: 'When a trustee suit is dis-
- 4 continued or settled by the principal parties thereto before
- 5 the return day of the writ, the trustee shall be entitled to
- 6 no costs, provided the plaintiff or his attorney shall notify
- 7 the trustee in writing, before the return day of the writ,
- 8 that the action has been discontinued.'
