STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT in relation to the Collection of Taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION. 1. Section one hundred and eighty-two of
2 chapter six of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
3 by prefixing thereto the following words to wit:

‘The collector of taxes of any town and,’ so that said
5 section when thus amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 182. The collector of taxes of any town and
7 the treasurer of any town who is also a collector, may
8 issue his warrant to the sheriff of any county or his dep-
9 uty or to a constable of his town directing him to distraint

10 the person or property of any person delinquent in pay-
11 ing his taxes after the expiration of the time fixed for
12 payment by vote of the town which warrant shall be of
13 the same tenor as that prescribed to be issued by munici-
14 pal officers or assessors to collectors with the appropriate
15 changes returnable to the collector or treasurer issuing
16 the same in thirty, sixty or ninety days.'
