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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to fix the Salary of the County Attorney for the  
County of Lincoln.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

On and after the first day of January in the year of our  
2 Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, the  
3 salary of the county attorney of Lincoln county shall be  
4 four hundred dollars per annum instead of the sum now  
5 established by law.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The salary of the County Attorney of Lincoln County is at present \$250 per year and covers all expenses. He is obliged to attend law terms and is debarred from practice in criminal cases, and has no portion of expenses in law court cases paid.
