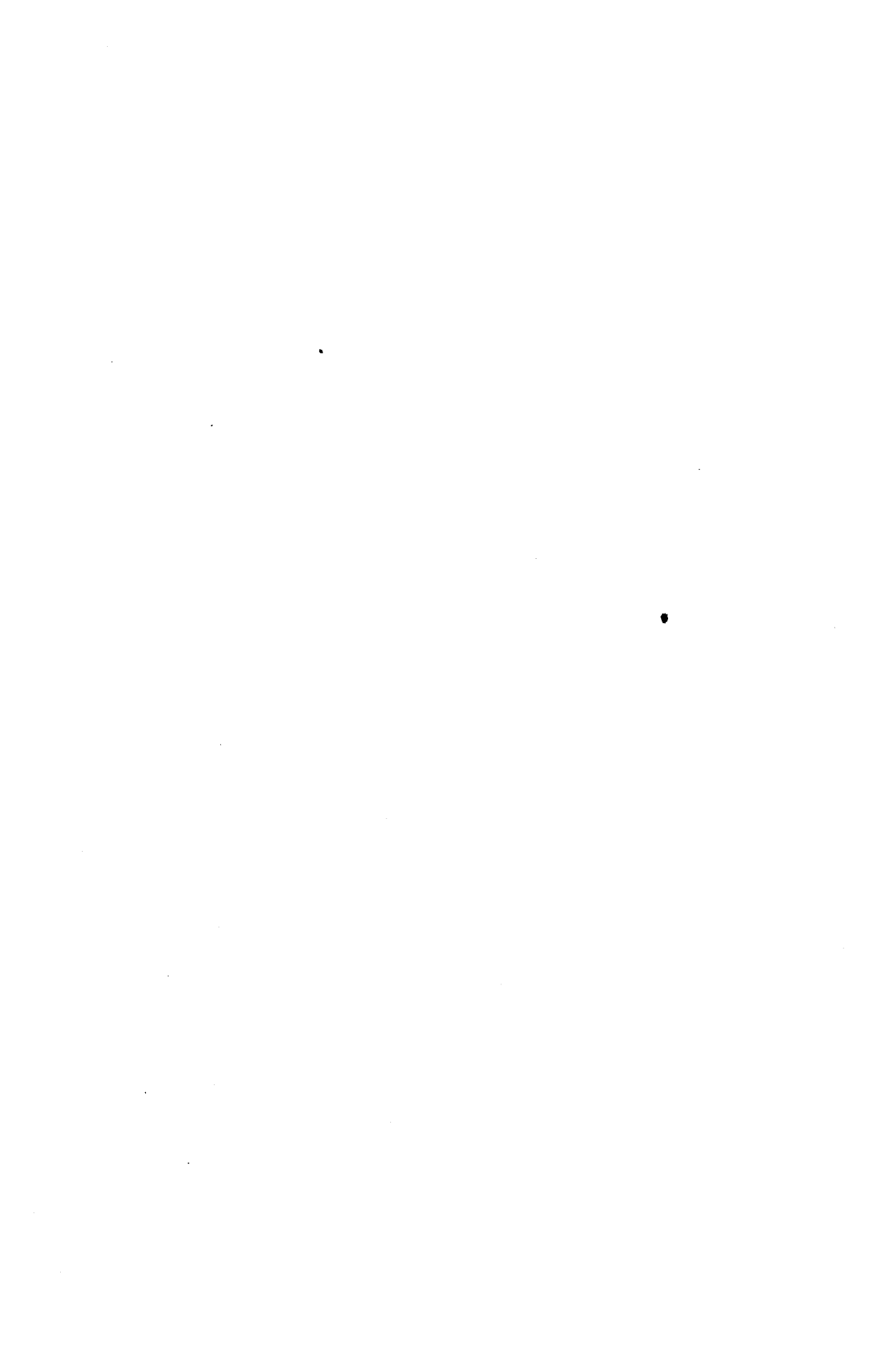

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Moscow. 4

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500)
2 be and is hereby appropriated to aid the town of Moscow
3 in building a road.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The object of this appropriation is to relieve the inhabitants of the town of Moscow who have been required by the county commissioners of Somerset county to build a new road across a portion of their town for the convenience and benefit of the public in the adjoining towns but of no benefit to the town of Moscow. The cost of which, when completed, (namely from \$1,200 to \$1,500), bears heavily on this small, poor town, so much so as to work great hardship.
