STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Additional Appropriation of Two
Hundred Dollars for Repair of Roads across Indian
Township.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600)
2 be and is hereby appropriated for the years 1893 and 1894
3 to repair roads across Indian Township.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The State has each year appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) for repair of roads across Indian Township in Washington County. The road to be kept in repair is 12 miles long and is continually used by heavily loaded teams hauling bark, leather, hides, etc. This amount that has annually hitherto been appropriated, the County Commissioners state is insufficient and ask for an additional sum of two hundred dollars for each of the years of 1893 and 1894, making the amount six hundred dollars.
