STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of building a road in Jerusalem Township
in Franklin County.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and
2 the same is hereby appropriated, to be expended under
3 the direction of the county commissioners of Franklin
4 county in building a road in Jerusalem township in said
5 county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road was recently laid out by the County Commissioners of Franklin County on petition signed by about 400 persons ; it is about 5 miles long, extends by a quite direct valley route from the county road into the northern section Franklin County, to the County road into the northern section of Somerset County, and would abreviate 60 per cent the travel to or from those sections, and would very much help in encouraging the settlers and developing that section of the State.
