STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent throwing waste and refuse lumber into
Webb's River in Carthage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall throw or put
2 into Webb's river, in Carthage, any waste or refuse lum-
3 ber, excepting planer shavings and saw dust.

SECT. 2. Any person who violates the provisions of
2 section one shall be subject to a penalty of not less than
3 five dollars and not more than twenty-five dollars, to be
4 recovered in an action of debt by any party injured, or by
5 indictment.
