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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to authorize the Kennebec Log Driving Company  
to maintain Piers and Booms in the Kennebec River, near  
the Town of Chelsea.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Kennebec Log Driving Company is  
2 hereby authorized and empowered to locate and maintain  
3 in the Kennebec river, beginning at a point about ten  
4 rods north of the ferry between Hallowell and Chelsea,  
5 and thence running northerly about one hundred and  
6 twenty-five rods, along the easterly shore of the Kenne-  
7 bec river, and east of the channel of said river, piers and  
8 booms for the purpose of holding, storing, sorting and  
9 rafting logs and all other lumber coming down said Ken-

10 nebec river, in connection with the other booms of said  
11 corporation, above and below.

SECT. 2. Said piers and booms shall be so constructed  
2 as not to impede the use or navigation of said river.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
