STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Eastern Maine Railway Company
to build a bridge across the Penobscot river and extend its
railroad thereto.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Eastern Maine Railway Company is
2 hereby authorized to erect and maintain a bridge for its
3 railroad across the Penobscot river at some convenient
4 between the south line of the town of Veazie and the
5 present bridge of said company across said river.

SECT. 2. Said company is hereby authorized to change
2 and extend its railroad in the town of Brewer so as to
3 make a convenient connection with the easterly end of such
4 bridge, and to extend its road from the westerly end of

5 said bridge to a convenient point of connection with the
6 European & North American Railway.

SECT. 3. Said company for the location, construction,
2 repair and convenient use of such extension of its railroad,
3 may purchase, or take and hold, as for public uses, land
4 and all materials in and upon it; but the land so taken
5 shall not exceed four rods in width unless necessary for
6 excavation, embankment, materials or convenient ap-
7 proaches to said bridge.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
