STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to protect Black Bass in Highland Lake and its Outlet, in Bridgton, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, kill or fish for,

- 2 in any manner, any black bass in the waters of High-
- 3 land Lake or in the waters of the stream or outlet of said
- 4 lake above the first factory dam thereon, in Bridgton, in
- 5 the county of Cumberland, during the months of April,
- 6 May and June, under a penalty of ten dollars fine or
- 7 thirty days' imprisonment, upon complaint and conviction
- 8 before any trial justice in the county of Cumberland.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
