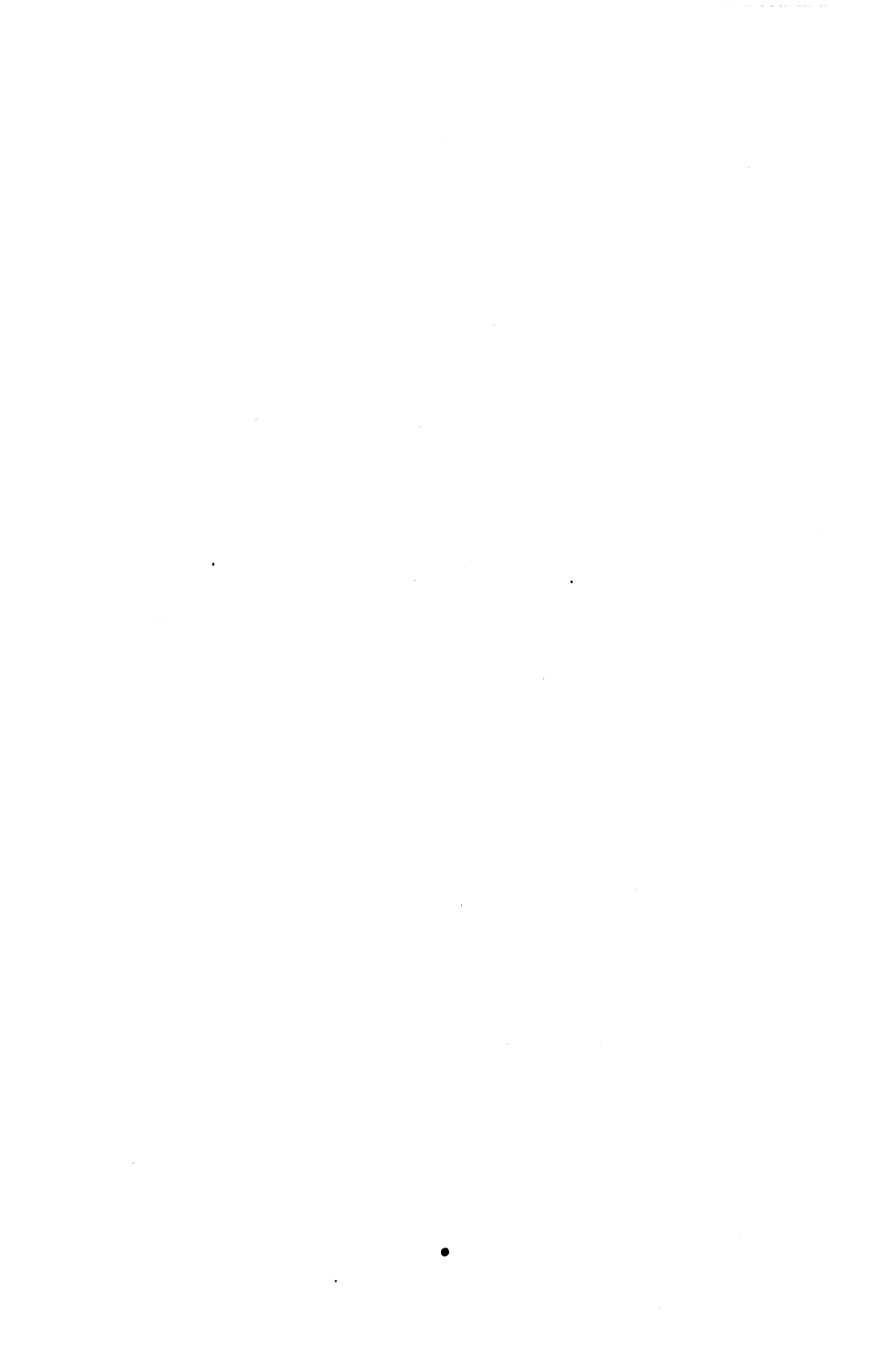
AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Fish from Labrador Pond
and Little Labrador Pond, in the Town of Sumner, in the
County of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take fish of any
2 kind from Labrador pond or Little Labrador pond, in the
3 town of Sumner, in the county of Oxford, by the use of
4 live bait or of any trap of any kind.

SECT. 2. No person shall fish for or take fish of any
2 kind, for the term of six years, from the stream running
3 out of said Labrador pond, between the point of outlet of
4 said Labrador pond and where said stream enters the
5 East Branch, so called, a distance of about one mile.

SECT. 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act, shall be punished by fine of five dollars for
3 each fish so taken, to be recovered on complaint before
4 any trial justice or other court in said Oxford county, one-
5 half to the use of the complainant, and the other half to
6 the use of said county.
