STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Fish from Labrador Pond and Little Labrador Pond, in the Town of Sumner, in the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take fish of any 2 kind from Labrador pond or Little Labrador pond, in the 3 town of Sumuer, in the county of Oxford, by the use of 4 live bait or of any trap of any kind.

SECT. 2. No person shall fish for or take fish of any 2 kind, for the term of six years, from the stream running 3 out of said Labrador pond, between the point of outlet of 4 said Labrador pond and where said stream enters the 5 East Branch, so called, a distance of about one mile.

SECT. 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act, shall be punished by fine of five dollars for 3 each fish so taken, to be recovered on complaint before 4 any trial justice or other court in said Oxford county, one-5 half to the use of the complainant, and the other half to 6 the use of said county.
