STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT regulating the taking of Fish in Rodgers Pond, in
the Town of Ripley in Somerset County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No pickerel shall be taken in any manner
2 from Rodgers pond, in the town of Ripley, in Somerset
3 county between the first days of November and May fol-
4 lowing in each year, for the term of six years from the
5 passage of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this
2 act shall, on conviction of the same, before any trial justice
3 in Somerset county, forfeit the sum of five dollars for each
4 fish so taken, one-half to the complainant and one-half to
5 the county of Somerset.
