STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Canada Road.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars be and
2 is hereby appropriated to be expended in repairing the
3 Canada road across Sandy Bay Township to the Canada
4 line, said sum to be expended under the direction of the
5 county commissioners of Somerset County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The object of this appropriation is to repair the State road leading from Moose river to the Canada line.

The northern half of said road which passes through the township of Sandy Bay, being now almost impassable, and a tax on the land owners sufficient to put it in suitable repair would be excessive and burdensome.

This road is much used by emigrants, and by lumbermen in transporting supplies to the woods above, and is also a mail route through to Quebec.
