STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize Camden Village Corporation, to rebuild
its hall building, or to sell its lot and expend its funds for
municipal purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Camden Village Corporation is hereby
2 authorized and vested with power, to raise money by loan
3 for the purpose of rebuilding or assisting in rebuilding its
4 village hall building, destroyed by fire, and for furnishing
5 the same, said loan not to exceed thirty thousand dollars,
6 and to issue its bonds for said purpose, on such time and
7 at such rate of interest as said corporation may vote; or
8 to sell its lot and expend its funds for any public and
9 municipal purposes, within the limits of said corporation,

10 that said corporation may vote, and should said corpora-
11 tion vote to sell its lot, the treasurer thereof, is hereby
12 authorized to execute the necessary deed or deeds for
13 such purpose.

SECT. 2. Neither of the above provisions shall take
2 effect as a law until ratified by the legal voters of said cor-
3 poration, at any legal meeting thereof, and when one of
4 said provisions has been ratified as aforesaid, and carried
5 into effect, the other shall become null and void.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
