STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter ninety of the Revised
Statutes relating to Mortgages of Real Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Paragraph one of section five of chapter ninety of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 word "printed" in the first line of said paragraph and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the words 'published and printed
5 in whole or in part' so that said paragraph as amended
6 shall read as follows :

1—He may give public notice in a newspaper published
8 and printed in whole or in part in the county where the

9 premises are situated, if any, or if not, in the State paper,
10 three weeks successively, of his claim by mortgage on
11 such real estate, describing the premises intelligibly, and
12 naming the date of the mortgage, and that the condition
13 in it is broken, by reason whereof he claims a foreclosure ;
14 and cause a copy of such printed notice, and the name
15 and date of the newspaper in which it was last published
16 to be recorded in each registry in which the mortgage
17 deed is or by law ought to be recorded, within thirty
18 days after such last publication.
