STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the taking of Fish from Drew's Lake
in Aroostook County, Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are forbidden fishing for, or
2 taking any fish from the waters of Drew's lake in Aroostook
3 county, Maine, for the term of four years from the first
4 day of April, A. D. 1893.

SECT. 2. Any person who violates the provision of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding twenty-
3 five dollars, or in default thereof, by imprisonment of not
4 less than ten nor more than thirty days.

SECT. 3. The fines and penalties provided by this act
2 may be recovered on complaint before any trial justice in
3 Aroostook county, Maine.
