IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT To enable the City of Calais to maintain Free  
Bridges across the St. Croix River.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows.*

SECTION 1. The city of Calais is hereby authorized to  
2 lay out and construct a highway across the St. Croix  
3 river from some point at or near the end of the Ferry  
4 Point toll bridge in said Calais to the boundary line  
5 between the State of Maine and the Province of New  
6 Brunswick and for that purpose to buy or build a bridge  
7 and maintain the same. Said city is also authorized to

8 lay out highways and build bridges at such points across  
9 said river as it may deem proper above said Ferry Point  
10 bridge.

SECT. 2. The use of said bridges for street cars, gas  
2 and water pipes, electric wires and for similar purposes  
3 shall be subject to such conditions as said city of Calais may  
4 impose, but no person shall be required to pay toll for travel-  
5 ing on or over said bridges.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
