RESOLVE in favor of Calais Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500)
2 be and is hereby appropriated annually for ten years to
3 aid Calais academy.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The funds of Calais academy have become nearly exhausted. It has always been in a flourishing condition, and benefited a large number of pupils in that section of the State. The academy has never before applied for State aid, while nearly every academy in the State has received the same.
