## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section Five of Chapter Three Hundred dred and Twenty-four of the Public Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-five, in relation to the jurisdiction of the Superior Court of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section five of chapter three hundred and
- 2 twenty-four of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 eighty-five is hereby repealed and the following inserted
- 4 in lieu thereof, to-wit:
  - 'Within said county said superior court shall have con-
- 6 current appellate jurisdiction of civil appeals from mu-
- 7 nicipal courts, police courts, and trial justices, and con-
- 8 current original jurisdiction of actions of scire facias

- 9 on judgments and recognizances, of bastardy trials, of
- 10 proceedings in habeas corpus, and of actions of trespass
- 11 quare clausum, and of all other civil actions at law not
- 12 exclusively cognizable by municipal courts, police courts
- 13 and trial justices, except complaints for flowage and real
- 14 actions.'
  - SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
- 2 this act are hereby repealed; and this act shall take effect
- 3 when approved.
