STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT amendatory of Chapter 70 of the Private Laws of
1881 entitled “An act additional to an act entitled ‘An
act to incorporate the Sebois Dam Company’ approved
February 22, 1869.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 70 of the Private
2 Acts of 1881 is hereby amended by inserting in the fifth
3 line thereof after the words “so called” the words ‘or
4 which shall arrive at the place of manufacture,’ and after
5 the words “Penobscot Boom” in the ninth line thereof
6 the words ‘or place of manufacture,’ so that said section
7 as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. Instead of the toll now provided, the said
9 corporation may demand and receive a toll of forty cents
10 for each thousand feet, board measure, woods scale, for
11 all logs driven over their dam, erected or to be erected
12 at or near the outlet of Trout lake, or Endless lake, so
13 called, or which shall arrive at the place of manufacture,
14 and said corporation shall have a lien on all such
15 logs for the payment of said toll; and if said toll is not
16 paid within ten days after said logs, or a major part
17 thereof, shall have arrived at the Penobscot Boom, or
18 place of manufacture, the corporation may sell at public
19 auction, in the city of Bangor, so many of said logs as
20 may be necessary to pay said toll with incidental charges,
21 first giving public notice of the time and place of sale in
22 some daily newspaper published in Bangor, but the logs
23 of each particular mark shall be holden only for the toll
24 on such mark.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
