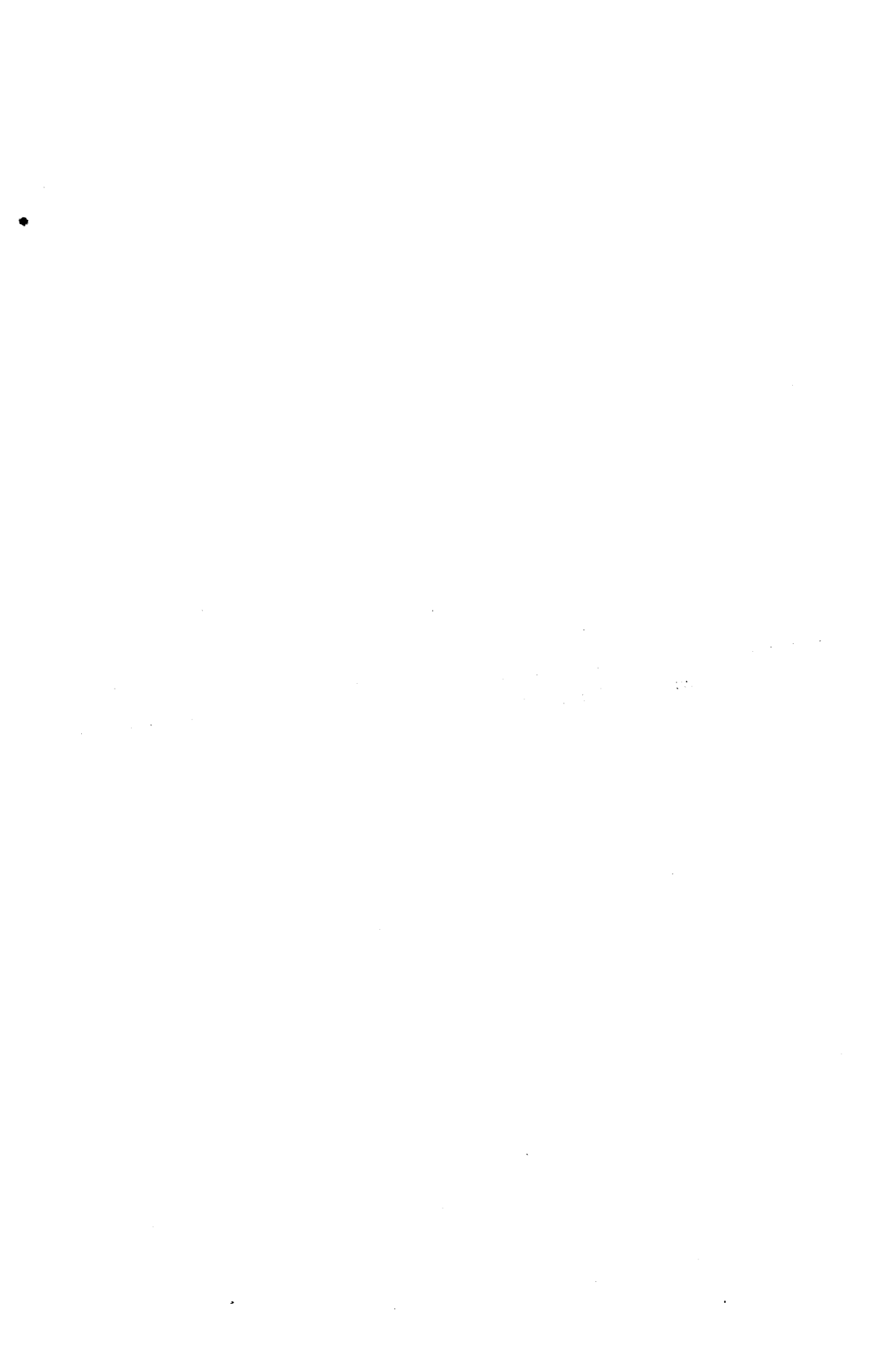

RESOLVE relating to the "School Lots" so called of the several plantations and unorganized townships of the State.

---

*Resolved,* That the land agent be directed to cause to be  
2 located the "school lot" or lots so called in each of the  
3 plantations or unorganized townships of the State that are  
4 ever likely to be organized, where at present there is no  
5 record of location, and where said school lots were reserved  
6 in the conveyance of the land of the several townships,  
7 and to prepare a complete record of the location of all  
8 such reserved lots of the State.
