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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend Section seven of Chapter forty-seven of  
the Private and Special Laws of 1887, establishing the  
Waterville and Fairfield Railroad.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section seven of chapter forty-seven of the private and  
2 special acts of the year 1887, is hereby amended by  
3 adding at the end thereof the following words:

‘And when any street or streets along which the track  
5 of said railroad shall be laid, shall be paved by the city of  
6 Waterville or the town of Fairfield, said railroad company

7 shall pay the expense of laying the pavement between the  
8 tracks or rails, said city or town to furnish the materials  
9 therefor and if said railroad company shall fail to pay the  
10 same within three months after said pavement shall be  
11 laid and completed, said city or town may recover of  
12 said railroad company said expense by action of debt in  
13 any court of competent jurisdiction.'
