STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Sections 11, 15, 21 and 22 of Chapter
52 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Steamboat Inspec-
tion Service in Inland Waters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Amend section 11 by striking out the
2 words "All steamboats carrying passengers" in the first
3 line and substituting therefor 'All vessels propelled by
4 steam.'

SECT. 2. Amend section 15 by striking out the last
2 paragraph of this section and substituting therefor, 'Every
3 such vessel shall carry such number of buckets and axes
4 for use in case of fire as the inspectors shall consider
5 necessary.'

SECT. 3. Amend section 21 by inserting the word
2 'collision' in the eleventh line of this section so that it
3 shall read, 'In case of damage by collision, fire or by
4 explosion of steam, etc.'

SECT. 4. Amend section 22 by inserting the word 'col-
2 lision' in the first line of this section so as to read: 'If the
3 death of any person is caused by such collision, explosion
4 or fire, etc.'
