IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Sections 11, 15, 21 and 22 of Chapter 52 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Steamboat Inspection Service in Inland Waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Amend section 11 by striking out the
- 2 words "All steamboats carrying passengers" in the first
- 3 line and substituting therefor 'All vessels propelled by
- 4 steam.'
 - SECT. 2. Amend section 15 by striking out the last
- 2 paragraph of this section and substituting therefor, 'Every
- 3 such vessel shall carry such number of buckets and axes
- 4 for use in case of fire as the inspectors shall consider
- necessary.'

- SECT. 3. Amend section 21 by inserting the word
- 2 'collision' in the eleventh line of this section so that it
- 3 shall read, 'In case of damage by collision, fire or by
- 4 explosion of steam, etc.'

SECT. 4. Amend section 22 by inserting the word 'col-

- 2 lision' in the first line of this section so as to read: 'If the
- 3 death of any person is caused by such collision, explosion
- 4 or fire, etc.'
