STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section two of chapter forty-six of the Revised Statutes, relating to Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter forty-six is hereby amended by

- 2 adding thereto the following: 'Directors must be and
- 3 remain stockholders, except that a member of another
- 4 corporation, which owns stock and has a right to vote
- 5 thereon, may be a director.' So that said section, as
- 6 amended, shall read as follows:
 - 'Section 2. Corporations may sue and be sued, plead
- 8 and be impleaded, in their corporate name; have a
- 9 common seal alterable at pleasure; elect all necessary offi-
- 10 cers; prescribe their duties and fix their compensation;

- 11 make by-laws consistent with the laws of the State and
- 12 their charters; and hold and convey lands and other
- 13 property. Directors must be and remain stockholders,
- 14 except that a member of another corporation, which owns
- 15 stock and has a right to vote thereon, may be a director.'
