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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter two hundred  
and one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-  
dred and fifty-four, relating to the powers of the Bridgton  
Centre Village Corporation.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred and  
2 one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred  
3 and fifty-four is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
4 following words: 'for the construction and repair of side-  
5 walks, sewers and a general sewerage system, for light-  
6 ing the streets, and for furnishing one or more police  
7 officers, night watchman, or other officers, within the  
8 limits of said corporation. Said corporation is also

9 invested with power to receive, hold and manage devises,  
10 bequests and gifts, and shall so hold and manage the  
11 same for any of the purposes of the corporation,' so that  
12 said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

‘Section 2. Said corporation is hereby invested with  
14 the power at any legal meeting called for the purpose, to  
15 raise such sums of money as may be sufficient for the  
16 purchase, repair and preservation of one or more fire  
17 engines, engine house, hose, buckets, ladders and other  
18 apparatus for the extinguishment of fire, for the construc-  
19 tion of reservoirs and aqueducts, for the procuring of  
20 water, and for organizing within the limits of said terri-  
21 tory an efficient fire department, for the construction and  
22 repair of sidewalks, sewers and a general sewerage  
23 system, for lighting the streets, and for furnishing one  
24 or more police officers, night watchman, or other officers,  
25 within the limits of said corporation. Said corporation  
26 is also invested with power to receive, hold and manage  
27 devises, bequests and gifts, and shall so hold and manage  
28 the same for any of the purposes of the corporation.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
