STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 122.

The objects of this appropriation is to aid the town of Concord in rebuilding an expensive wharfing on the bank of the Kennebec river over which the county road passes from Bingham Ferry to Pleasant Edge and Carrying Place Plantations the estimated cost of which is about fifteen hundred dollars. This road is largely for the benefit of the public outside of the town of Concord said town being heavily in debt and poorly able to bear the burden.
