STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to correct the Taxation of the Plantation of Lex-
ington, Somerset County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The plantation of Lexington shall be here-
2 after exempt from the payment of State and county taxes
3 except so far as other townships containing less than two
4 hundred inhabitants are taxed.

SECT. 2. All State and county taxes on said plantation
2 heretofore assessed for the years 1891 and 1892 and
3 remaining unpaid are hereby abated.

SECT. 3. All moneys apportioned to the plantation of
2 Lexington during the years 1891 and 1892 on account of
3 school and mill tax funds are hereby withheld and the
4 treasurer of State is hereby authorized to cancel the same
5 on his books.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
