RESOLVE in aid of building bridge across Moluncus stream  
in Silver Ridge Plantation, County of Aroostook.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars shal  
2 be and hereby is appropriated to aid in building bridge  
3 across Moluncus stream in Silver Ridge Plantation in the  
4 County of Aroostook, said sum to be expended by the  
5 county commissioners of Aroostook county.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Silver Ridge plantation had a valuation in 1890 of only \$43,200. They have a great amount of hard road to keep in repair. This bridge across the Moluncus is old and entirely unsafe and must be built new. The expense of rebuilding this bridge in this poor plantation, will be a heavy burden upon the citizens of that plantation and the State should as they think, assist them in the construction of the bridge.
