STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter forty-eight of the Revised
Statutes, relating to changing the location of Corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Any corporation organized under sections sixteen and
2 seventeen, of chapter forty-eight, of the Revised Statutes,
3 at a legal meeting of its stockholders, may by a vote
4 representing a majority of the stock issued, change its
5 location from one county to another in this State, and
6 the corporation shall file, by its clerk or other officer, in
7 the registry of deeds in each of said counties, within
8 twenty days after such change of location, the certificate
9 required by section eleven of chapter forty-six of the

10 Revised Statutes, as amended by section two of chapter
11 two hundred sixty-three of the Public Laws of eighteen
12 hundred eighty-nine.
