HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT No. 57.

Section 1 of Senate Document number 57 is hereby amended by striking out the word "and" in the third line and adding after the word "workshops" the words 'mines and quarries.'

Section 2 of said document is hereby amended by striking out the word "and" in the fifth line and adding after the word "workshops" the words 'mines and quarries,' so that said sections as amended shall read as follows :

'Section 1. The official title of the officer now known as Deputy Commissioner of Labor is hereby changed to Inspector of Factories, Workshops, Mines and Quarries.'

Section 2. Chapter 139 of the Public Laws of 1887 is hereby amended by striking out the words “deputy commissioner of labor” wherever they occur in said chapter and inserting in their place the words ‘inspector of factories, workshops, mines and quarries.’
