STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to incorporate the Brunswick Village Corporation."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-two of

- 2 the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 eighty-seven entitled "An Act to incorporate the Bruns-
- 4 wick Village Corporation" is hereby revived and re-enacted,
- 5 and the twelfth section thereof is hereby amended by
- 6 striking out the name of Charles C. Humphreys from the
- 7 fifth line of said section and inserting instead thereof the
- 8 name of Franklin C. Webb.

- SECT. 2. The period of five years mentioned in the
- 2 second line of said twelfth section shall run from the date
- 3 when this act shall be approved.
 - SECT. 3. The organization to be created by this act and
- 2 by the acceptance thereof shall have the same right which
- 3 towns have to accept chapter two hundred and eighty-five
- 4 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine
- 5 and the last mentioned acceptance shall have the same
- 6 effect as to the powers and obligations of said corporations
- 7 which the like acceptance has in the case of a town.
