IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to incorporate the Brunswick
Village Corporation."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-two of
2 the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-seven entitled "An Act to incorporate the Bruns-
4 wick Village Corporation" is hereby revived and re-enacted,
5 and the twelfth section thereof is hereby amended by
6 striking out the name of Charles C. Humphreys from the
7 fifth line of said section and inserting instead thereof the
8 name of Franklin C. Webb.

SECT. 2. The period of five years mentioned in the
2 second line of said twelfth section shall run from the date
3 when this act shall be approved.

SECT. 3. The organization to be created by this act and
2 by the acceptance thereof shall have the same right which
3 towns have to accept chapter two hundred and eighty-five
4 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine
5 and the last mentioned acceptance shall have the same
6 effect as to the powers and obligations of said corporations
7 which the like acceptance has in the case of a town.
