STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to extend the time for the location and construction of a Roadway or Bridge over the Tide Waters at Norwood's Cove in the town of Tremont.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the location and construction
2 of a roadway or bridge over tide waters at the mouth of
3 Norwood's Cove, so called, at South West Harbor in the
4 town of Tremont, county of Hancock, as authorized by
5 chapter three hundred and ninety-four of the Private and
6 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is here-
7 by extended two years from the date of approval of this
8 act.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
