STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter four hundred forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of 1868, entitled An Act to prevent the throwing of slabs or other refuse into the Penobscot River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of said chapter four hundred

- 2 forty-eight is hereby amended by inserting after the word
- 3 "dollars" in the last line of said section, the words 'nor
- 4 shall any person or persons cast or throw into said Penob-
- 5 scot river below the mouth of the Mattawamkeag river
- 6 or into any of its tributaries entering below the mouth
- 7 of said Mattawamkeag river between the first day of
- 8 November of each year and the time of the freezing up

9 of Penobscot river any planer shavings, and no person 10 or persons shall so place, pile or deposit on the banks of 11 said Penobscot river or the banks of any of said tributaries any planer shavings in such negligent or careless 13 manner that the same shall fall or be washed into said 14 river or said tributaries or with the intent that the same 15 shall fall or be washed into said river or tributaries between the first day of November of each year and the 17 time of the freezing up of the Penobscot river, under 18 the same penalties,' so that said section as amended shall 19 read as follows:

'Section 1. No person or persons shall cast or throw 21 into the Penobscot river, below the mouth of the Mattamkeag river, or into any of its tributaries entering below the mouth of said Mattawamkeag river, any slabs, board or lath edgings, bark, grindings of edgings, wood, bark or lumber, or refuse wood or timber of any sort, or shall place, pile or deposit on the 27 banks of said Penobscot river, or banks of said tributa-28 ries, any slabs, board or lath edgings, bark, grindings of edgings, bark, wood or lumber, or refuse wood or tim-29 ber of any sort, in such negligent or careless manner that the same shall fall or be washed into said river or said tributaries, or with the intent that the same shall fall or be washed into said river or said tributaries, whereby the navigation of said river may become impeded or injuriously affected, or which shall tend to impede or inju-36 riously affect the navigation of, or fill up said river, un-

- 37 der a penalty, for each offence, if the quantity shall not
- 38 exceed five cords, of not less than five nor more than
- 39 twenty dollars; if the quantity east or thrown in, or that
- 40 shall fall or be washed in, as aforesaid, at one or differ-
- 41 ent times, shall exceed five cords in all, under a penalty
- 42 of not less than twenty nor more than five hundred dol-
- 43 lars; nor shall any person or persons cast or throw into
- 44 said Penobscot river below the mouth of the Mattawam-
- 45 keag river, or into any of its tributaries entering below
- 46 the mouth of said Mattawamkeag river, between the first
- 47 day of November of each year and the time of the freez-
- 48 ing up of Penobscot river, any planer shavings, and no
- 49 person or persons shall so place, pile or deposit on the
- 50 banks of said Penobscot river or the banks of any of said
- 51 tr ibutaries any planer shavings in such negligent or care-
- 52 less manner that the same shall fall or be washed into
- 53 said river or said tributaries, or with the intent that the
- 54 same shall fall or be washed into said river or tributaries
- 55 between the first day of November of each year and
- 56 the time of the freezing up of the Penobscot river, under
- 57 the same penalties.'
 - SECT. 2. Said chapter four hundred and forty-eight is
 - 2 further hereby amended by adding thereto the following
- 3 section:
 - 'Section 4. No person or persons shall cast or throw
- 5 from any new mill, built on any new mill site or old mill
- 6 site, into the Penobscot river below the mouth of the
- 7 Mattawamkeag river or into any of its tributaries entering

- 8 below the mouth of said Mattawamkeag river any saw-
- 9 dust or planer shavings or so place, pile or deposit on the
- 10 banks of said Penobscot river or the banks of any of its
- 11 said tributaries any sawdust or planer shavings in such
- 12 negligent or careless manner that the same shall fall or
- 13 be washed into said river or said tributaries, or with the
- 14 intent that the same shall fall or be washed into said
- 15 river or said tributaries under a penalty, for each offence,
- 16 if the quantity shall not exceed five cords, of not less
- 17 than five nor more than twenty dollars; if the quantity
- 18 cast or thrown in, or that shall fall or be washed in, as
- 19 aforesaid, at one or different times, shall exceed five cords
- 20 in all, under a penalty of not less than twenty nor more
- 21 than five hundred dollars.'

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
