STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to grant aid by the State in building a bridge
across the Meduxnekeag Stream, so called, in the town of
Amity, County of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) is
2 hereby appropriated to aid in building a bridge across the
3 Meduxnekeag stream in the town of Amity County of
4 Aroostook providing the same be built of iron and to the
5 acceptance of the county commissioners.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Amity with a population of 420 inhabitants and a valuation of \$53,660 has seven bridges to keep in repair. That which crosses the Meduxnekeag stream near Davis Mills must be rebuilt the present year. The span is eighty-four feet in length and the highest above water thirty-five feet. The estimated cost will be one thousand dollars for a wooden bridge. Estimated cost of an iron bridge is \$1,500. The said bridge is a public benefit to several surrounding towns and plantations and will accommodate much greater travel when the Aroostook railroad is completed.
