STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That the sum forty-two thousand five hundred

- 2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf
- 3 of the State Reform School for the years eighteen hun-
- 4 dred and ninety-three and eighteen hundred and ninety-
- 5 four for the following purposes: for the year eighteen
- 6 hundred and ninety-three for current expenses including
- 7 mechanical school and new cottage eighteen thousand
- 8 dollars; for ordinary repairs two thousand dollars; special
- 9 repairs two thousand dollars; furnishing new cottage two
- 10 thousand five hundred dollars. For the year eighteen
- 11 hundred and ninety-four for current expenses, including
- 12 mechanical school and new cottage eighteen thousand
- 13 dollars. And of the above named amount twenty-four
- 14 thousand five hundred or so much thereof as is necessary

- 15 for the above named purposes shall be payable in the
- $16\ \mathrm{year}$ eighteen hundred and ninety-three and eighteen
- 17 thousand dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary for
- 18 the above named purposes, in the year eighteen hundre ${f d}$
- 19 and ninety-four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The committee having carefully examined the buildings and needs of the State Reform School, recommend the following for current expenses, including mechanical school and new cottage, for the year 1893, the sum of \$18,000; ordinary repairs, \$2,000; special repairs, \$2,000; furnishing new cottage, \$2,500. And for the year 1894, for current expenses, including mechanical school and new cottage, \$18,000. The last named amount being two thousand less than the sum asked for by the trustees.
