STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Sections five, twelve and thirteen of
Chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the fees
for travel of Officers, Jurors and Witnesses in Washington
County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 116 of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding to the nineteenth
3 paragraph of said section, the following to wit: '*Provided,*
4 *however,* that the fees for travel as aforesaid of the sheriff
5 of the county of Washington and of his deputies, in serv-
6 ing civil processes shall be eight cents a mile each way
7 instead of six cents as hereinbefore provided.'

SECT. 2. Section 12 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following to wit: '*Provided, however,* that such jurors in the county of Washington shall be allowed eight cents a mile for their travel each way, instead of six cents as hereinbefore provided.'

SECT. 3. Section 13 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter 265 of the Public Laws of 1885, is hereby further amended, by adding thereto the following to wit: '*Provided, however,* that all such witnesses shall receive eight cents a mile each way for their travel in the county of Washington.'

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
