STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to change the salary of the Judge of Waterville
Municipal Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Chapter three hundred and twenty-nine of the Private
2 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled an
3 act to amend an act establishing a municipal court in the
4 town of Waterville is hereby amended by striking out
5 the words "twelve hundred" in the sixth line of the
6 second paragraph of the first section of said act, and
7 inserting the words 'seven hundred' in their stead, also
8 by adding to said chapter the following: 'Nothing in
9 this act shall be construed to give said court the power
10 to naturalize aliens, or to receive their applications for
11 naturalization.'
