STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section seven of Chapter thirty-six of the
Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter thirty-six of the
2 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is
3 hereby amended by striking out all of said section after
4 the word "town" in the fifth line thereof, and substitute
5 therefor the following, 'and thereupon the town clerk
6 shall make a record of the total result, and the selectmen
7 and town clerk shall forthwith send to the secretary of
8 State due and proper official returns thereof in the form
9 prescribed by law;' so that said section as amended shall
10 read :

‘Section 7. The warden shall receive the ballots at such
12 elections and perform the duties specified in section forty-
13 four of chapter four of the Revised Statutes, but the list
14 shall be delivered within twenty-four hours after the clos-
15 ing of the polls to the clerk of said town, and thereupon
16 the town clerk shall make a record of the total result,
17 and the selectmen and town clerk shall forthwith send
18 to the secretary of State due and proper official returns
19 thereof in the form prescribed by law.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
