STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section 9, chapter 95 of the Public Laws
of 1891 relative, to the close time on cow Moose.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 95 of the Public Laws
2 of 1891 is hereby amended by striking out all of said
3 section after the figure "9" and inserting the following
4 words: 'Whoever hunts, catches, kills or destroys with
5 dogs, any moose forfeits one hundred dollars for every
6 moose so hunted, caught, killed or destroyed, and no
7 person shall, between the first days of January and
8 October in any manner hunt, catch, kill or destroy, or
9 have in possession, any moose, or part thereof, taken in
10 close time, under the same penalty;' so that said section
11 as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 9. Whoever hunts, catches, kills or destroys
13 with dogs, any moose forfeits one hundred dollars for
14 every moose so hunted, caught, killed or destroyed, and
15 no person shall between the first days of January and
16 October in any manner hunt, catch, kill, destroy or have
17 in possession any moose or part thereof, taken in close
18 time under the same penalty.’

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.
