STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-nine of Chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes, to provide for the payment of expenses of last sickness and funeral expenses of widow out of the estate of deceased husband.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-nine of chapter sixty-four of the Revised

- 2 Statutes be amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 words: 'And on petition of any person interested, the
- 4 judge of probate may also allow a reasonable sum for the
- 5 erection of grave stones, for funeral expenses and expenses
- 6 of last sickness of the widow of the deceased, provided she
- 7 dies before the final settlement of her husband's estate and
- 8 her estate is insufficient for the above purposes.'
