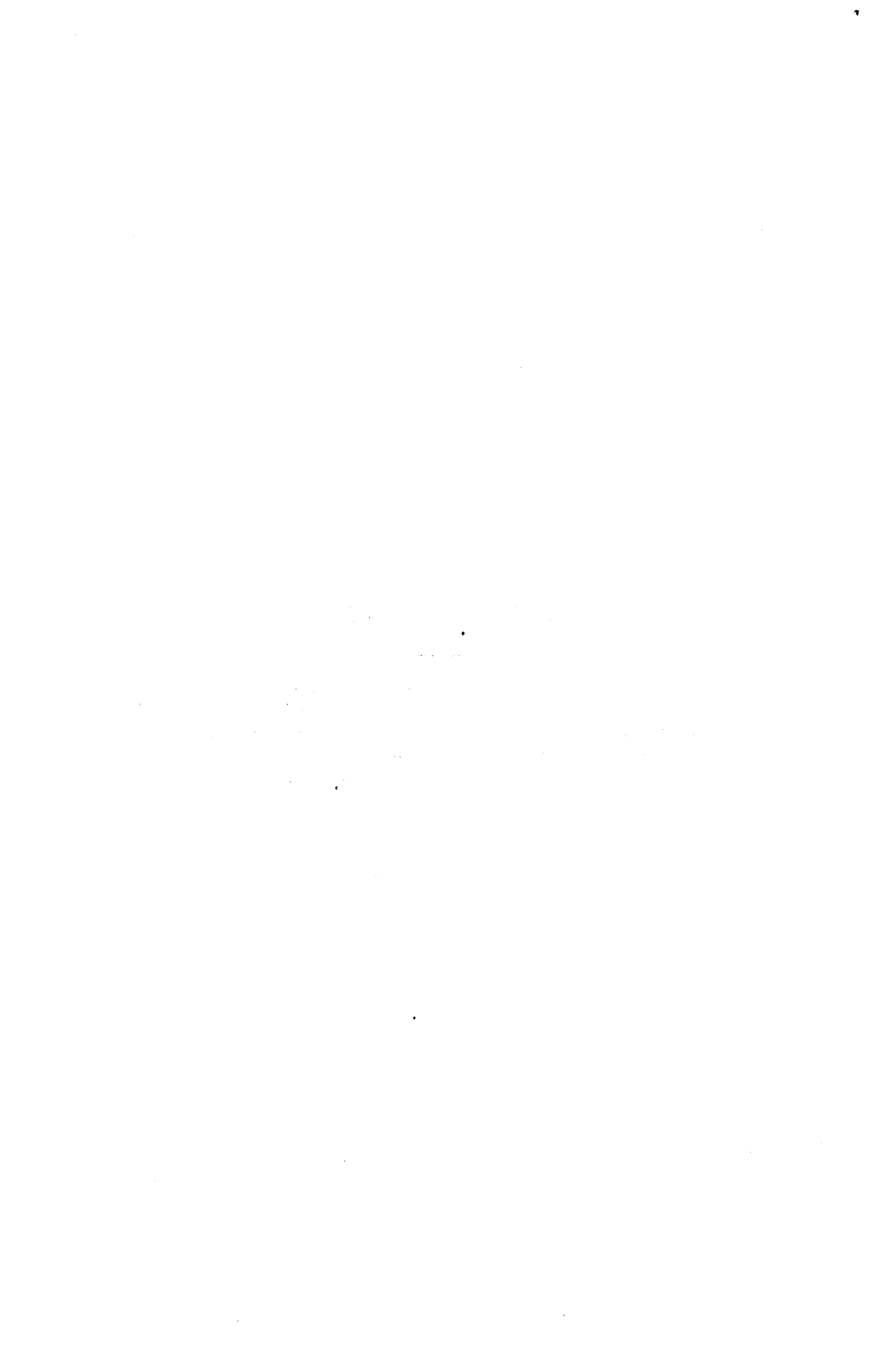
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-nine of Chapter sixty-four
of the Revised Statutes, to provide for the payment of
expenses of last sickness and funeral expenses of widow
out of the estate of deceased husband.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section fifty-nine of chapter sixty-four of the Revised
2 Statutes be amended by adding thereto the following:
3 words: 'And on petition of any person interested, the
4 judge of probate may also allow a reasonable sum for the
5 erection of grave stones, for funeral expenses and expenses
6 of last sickness of the widow of the deceased, provided she
7 dies before the final settlement of her husband's estate and
8 her estate is insufficient for the above purposes.'
