STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of continuing the Publication of York
Deeds.

Resolved, That the Maine Historical Society agreeing
2 to supervise the copying, attesting, editing, indexing and
3 publishing of volumes nine and ten of the public records
4 of this State in the office of the register of deeds for
5 York county, in the same creditable manner as in the
6 eight preceding volumes already published, except that
7 they are not required to be leaded, because of their
8 increased size, the Governor and Council shall purchase
9 for the State four hundred and fifty copies of volume
10 nine, a like number of volume ten at five dollars per

11 volume ; and the State librarian shall cause one copy of
12 each volume to be placed in each registry of deeds in
13 this State, the remaining copies to be distributed or
14 exchanged at the discretion of said librarian.
