RESOLVE in favor of the Mattawamkeag Bridge.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and
2 is hereby appropriated to be expended in repairing the
3] bridge across the Mattawamkeag stream at Mattawamkeag,
4 said sum to be expended under the direction of an agent
5 to be appointed by the governor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge across the Mattawamkeag stream is owned and repaired by the State. The repairs asked for are a necessity as has been ascertained by a member of the Committee on Ways and Bridges, who examined it reported repairs necessary.
